These reforms are not administrative—they are foundational shifts in how we define professional competence in this country.

We are equally proud of our expanding ecosystem of training and learning. KISEB now works with 102 accredited training institutions across Kenya. These institutions are not just partners—they are the engines that prepare the next generation of professionals.

To the lecturers, trainers, and institutional leaders present here today, we recognise your role in shaping not just pass rates, but professional identity and ethical grounding.
